Do you own one of the new Intel Macs? If so, you can now use RADAR without switching to a PC!

Will it work on my Mac?

The Mac with Intel Duo Core processor was introduced in 2006. The MacBook and MacBook Pro use the Intel Duo Core Processor; PowerMac and older G3/G4 computers do not. Not sure about your Mac? Click the blue apple at the upper left of your screen, then choose 'About this Mac'. 'Processor information' tells if yours is an Intel Mac.

How does it work?

Before you begin using any Windows-based software on your Intel Mac, you'll first set up a Virtual Machine (VM), essentially a computer-within-a-computer. This involves purchasing and installing additional software. Once you've created your VM and installed Windows, you're ready to install RADAR & EH.
CAUTION: If you're not very, very comfortable with computers, we suggest using the services of a certified Mac tech to setup your VM and install & update Windows.

What will I need to purchase?

In addition to your Intel Mac, there are 3 things you will need before installing RADAR & EH. You may wish to discuss these purchases in advance with your tech.

- 1) **'Virtual Machine' software.**
There are 3 brands to choose from. (See VM Software Options table below).
- 2) **Microsoft Windows, XP Home or Pro Edition.**
- 3) **Internet access** for your new 'Virtual Machine' (or use your existing service).

Which VM Software should I choose?

There are 3 products on the market. We've summarized their features below, and recommend you consult your technician before making a decision to purchase.
